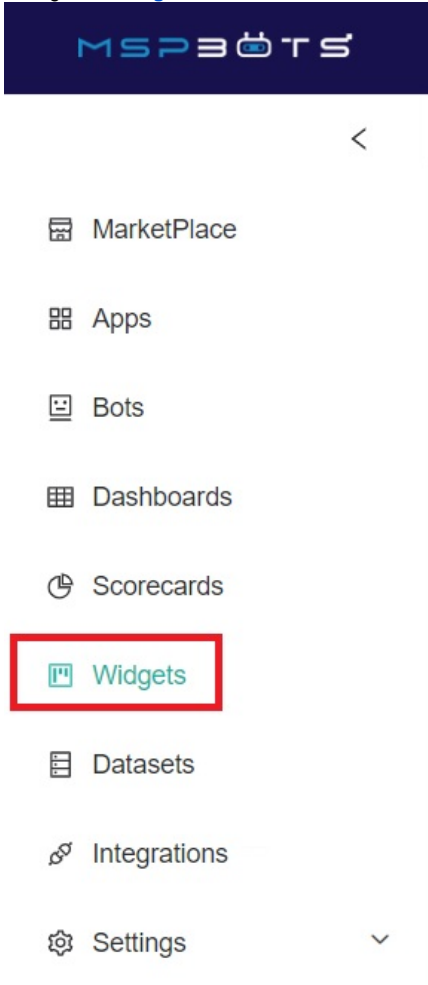


How to Change the Font Size of Texts in a Grid Widget

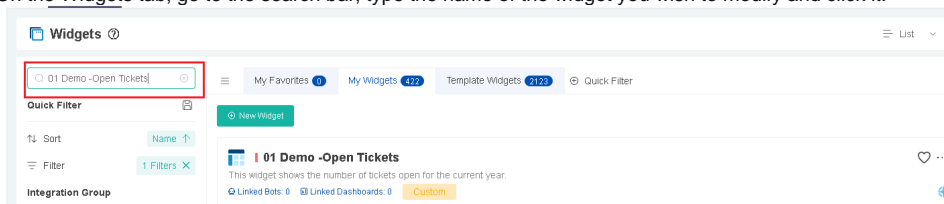
Some clients prefer to view reports in larger font sizes. This article has the steps for increasing the font size of texts in the grid widgets.

To increase the text's font size:

1. Navigate to [Widgets](#) on the MSPbots menu.




2. On the [Widgets](#) tab, go to the search bar, type the name of the widget you wish to modify and click it.



3. Next, click the **Config** icon on the Widget Builder window, then go the to **Grid Option** tab.
